

## The Daisy Code of Good Gunmanship

- *Treat every gun as if it were loaded and ready to shoot.*
- *Never carry a loaded or cocked gun into your home, camp, or a public place*
- *Always be sure your gun barrel is clean and unobstructed*
- *Carry your gun so that even if you stumble, you can control the direction of the muzzle*
- *Be sure of your target before you pull the trigger*
- *Never point a gun at anything you do not want to shoot*
- *Guns should always be unloaded when they are not being used.*
- *Never climb a tree or fence or jump a ditch with a loaded gun.*
- *Never shoot at a flat, hard surface or the surface of water.*
- *Respect the property of others.*

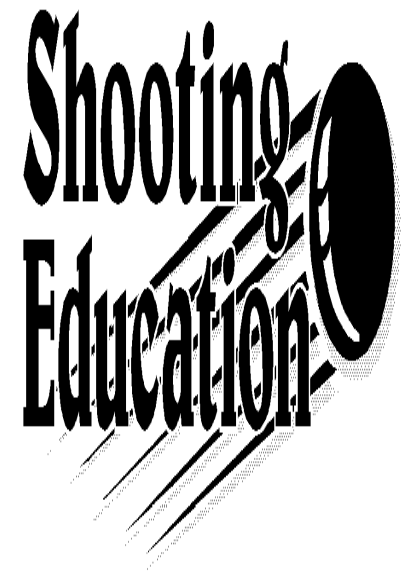

## Shooting Education Program

The Boyertown Rod & Gun Club Shooting Education program typically runs from November through April. We meet every Wednesday and Thursday evening at the Boyertown Rod & Gun Club, giving parents the choice of which evening to bring their child. The program is open to boys and girls between the ages of 8 and 15.



Compete in shooting events.

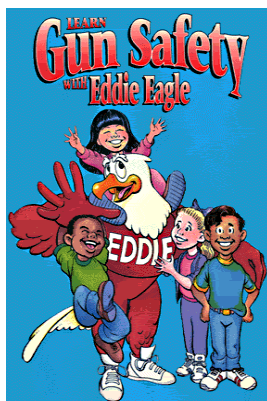
The first 6 weeks of our program consist of a hands on shooting safety and education course using the Daisy Ten Lesson Curriculum and Daisy Model 499 BB Guns. After completing the course the children may continue practicing at our supervised indoor BB-Gun range. There are several competitions throughout the year, giving the team a chance to compete against other teams from the area

## State Competition

There is also a State BB Gun Competition each year, where the top three teams from each state are invited to participate in the International BB Gun Competition. The top 3 teams are awarded team trophies and the top individual shooters in each shooting position are awarded individual medals.

## International Competition

The International BB Gun Championship Match takes place each summer, usually in July. Hundreds of children from all over the country compete for 2 days. The top teams and individual shooters are awarded trophies.
